

Fire Evacuation Plan

On discovering a fire...

- In the event of a fire (however small) Raise the alarm. Call the Fire and rescue service (999) and then inform Management (01256) 850 221 or Tim May (07855) 013 005
- Only attempt to extinguish a fire where there is no risk of personal injury either from the fire, from any toxic gases or from the structural failure of the building;
- Ensure that you have a clear emergency exit at all times.
- When attempting to extinguish a fire ensure that you use the appropriate type of extinguisher.

On hearing a fire alarm leave via the nearest exit close all doors behind you and report to the assembly point at the main entrance to folly farm.

For electrical, flammable liquid or general fires use **DRY POWDER**

Suitable for fires involving electrical fires or flammable liquids.

- On fires involving electrical equipment, switch off the current and then direct the jet straight at the fire.
- On fires involving either liquids in containers or spilled liquids, direct the jet towards the near edge of the fire. With a rapid sweeping motion drive the fire towards the far edge until all the flames are extinguished.
- On fires involving flowing liquids direct the jet at the base of the flames and sweep upwards.
